

How can you become a LIT student in the Preparatory year?

IF YOU WANT TO STUDY IN ROMANIA,

SPEND A YEAR WITH LIT,

LEARNING OR IMPROVING YOUR ROMANIAN

AND TRAINING FOR THE FIELD YOU WANT TO GET SPECIALIZED IN.

THIS PROGRAM WELCOMES STUDENTS FROM THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA, ALBANIA, BULGARIA, MACEDONIA, SERBIA, UKRAINE, HUNGARY, AND THE DIASPORA.

Candidates can become our students in three ways:

1. In order to obtain a **grant from the Romanian government** or to be a non-paying student, the candidates of Romanian ethnicity who graduated from a college or university in one of the above-mentioned countries should apply for a preliminary selection at the Romanian Consulate which will forward the application to the Romanian Ministry of Education for consideration and final selection.

2. The candidates who were not selected by the Romanian Ministry of Education can apply directly to the West University of Timișoara with the same documentation (which they submitted to the Romanian Consulate in their country), as paying students, in **the Romanian currency (lei)**. Candidates of Romanian ethnicity who have graduated from college in their country can apply directly to the the West University of Timișoara as paying students, in **the Romanian currency (lei)**.

3. Candidates of non-Romanian ethnicity can apply to the West University of Timișoara with the letter of acceptance issued by the Romanian Ministry of Education, as paying students in **the European currency (Euro)**.

The candidate's file is made up of:

1. *A folder;*
2. *Application form;*
3. *Copy of ID;*
4. *Legal copy of passport;*
5. *Candidate's declaration followed by personal and family documents proving their Romanian ethnicity;*
6. *Certificate issued by the Romanian consulate proving the Romanian ethnicity;*
7. *Medical certificate – original document and legal copy translated into Romanian;*
8. *A ¾ photo attached to the application form;*
9. *All school documents – original and legal copy translated into Romanian: baccalaureate diploma/certificate/graduation form; grade record; birth certificate.*
