WHO is eligible?

Qualified academic staff from any country (except Romania), who holds a PhD and a higher education teaching institutional affiliation.

General Eligibility Criteria

- International visibility of the candidate's academic profile
- International recognition of the candidate's activity
- Teaching achievements

Specific Eligibility Criteria

The candidate must be in possession of a doctoral degree, as required by the Romanian law.

The candidate must be specialized in Spanish and / or Latin American literatures.

The previous collaboration with the Spanish department of the Faculty of Letters, History and Theology (University of West Timisoara) represents an advantage, without being a mandatory criterion.

Description of the visiting professor position offered by the department of Spanish, Faculty of Letters, History and Theology, West University of Timișoara, university year 2021-2022

The Spanish department of the Faculty of Letters of the University of the West of Timisoara offers a visiting professor position specialized in Spanish and / or Latin American literature. The candidate is expected to teach both undergraduate and master's degrees students.

The courses available for teaching are the following:

- *Spanish literature: Middle Age and Renaissance*, addressed to first year BA students in Philology (in the first semester, course and seminar). The content of the course will place special emphasis on the most representative authors of this period, presented within the cultural context of medieval and Renaissance Spain.

- *Spanish Literature: Baroque*, addressed to second year BA students in Philology (in the first semester, course and seminar). The content of the subject is left to the choice of the professor, provided that he refers to the main and / or representative authors of the Spanish Golden Age literature.

- *Literary Models of the Romanic Space*, addressed to first-year students in the Master's degree programme in Romance Studies (first and second semester, course and seminar). It is a subject with a special openness towards comparative literature, in which the professor has freedom in choosing the content and approach s/he will adopt in his/her classes. Possible variants: avatars of realism in Spanish literature; Spanish literary archetypes (La Celestina, Don Quixote, Don Juan); continuities and ruptures in Hispanic literature; fate of Hispanic letters in the West, Latin American literatures in relation to trends in European literature, etc.

Other classes that can be offered: *Interpretation of poetry* addressed to third year BA students in Philology (in the second semester, course and seminar), *Introduction to literature* addressed to third year students in an Applied Modern Languages BA programme (first semester, course and seminar).

Descripción de la plaza dirigida a un profesor visitante para el curso académico 2021-2022

El departamento de español de la Facultad de Letras de la Universidad del Oeste de Timisoara oferta una plaza de profesor visitante especializado en literatura española y/o latinoamericana. El/la candidato/a impartirá docencia tanto en licenciatura como en máster y tendrá un mínimo de seis horas lectivas a la semana.

Las asignaturas propuestas de las que se hará cargo el/la candidato/a son las siguientes:

- *Literatura spaniolă Edad Media y Renacimiento* para los alumnos de primer curso de licenciatura en Filología (en el primer semestre, curso y seminario). El contenido de la asignatura pondrá especial énfasis en los autores más representativos de este período, presentados dentro del contexto cultural de la España medieval y renacentista.

- *Literatura spaniolă: Barroco* para los alumnos de segundo curso de licenciatura en Filología (en el primer semestre, curso y seminario). El contenido de la asignatura queda a la elección del profesor / de la profesora, siempre que se refiera a los principales representantes de la literatura aurea española.

- *Modelos literarios de la literatura románica*, destinado a alumnos de primer curso del Máster de Estudios Románicos (primer y segundo semestre, curso y seminario). Se trata de una asignatura con una especial apertura hacia la literatura comparada, en la que el profesor tiene una gran libertad en la elección del ángulo bajo el cual impartirá sus clases. Posibles variantes: avatares del realismo en la literatura española; arquetipos literarios españoles (la Celestina, Don Quijote, Don Juan); continuidades y rupturas en la literatura hispánica; destino de las letras hispánicas en Occidente; - la literatura latinoamericana en relación con las tendencias de la literatura europea, etc.

Otras clases que se pueden ofrecer: *Interpretación de la poesía* para alumnos de tercer curso de licenciatura en Filología (en el segundo semestre, curso y seminario); *Introducción a la literatura* para alumnos de tercer curso de licenciatura en Traducción e Interpretación (primer semestre, curso y seminario).
